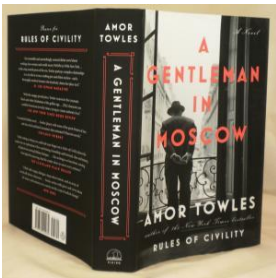


HOMESTEADING PRESENTATION
