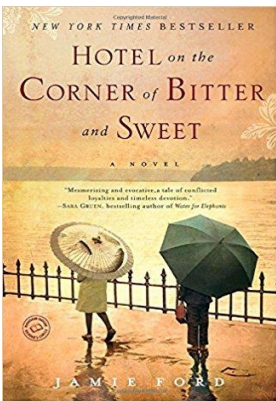


FOLKTALE WORKSHOP SERIES
