## VERMONT FARM KIDS MOVIE AND POTLUCK

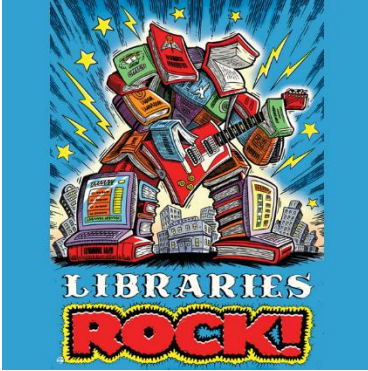

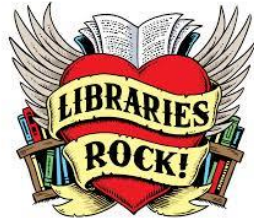
