## LOCAL ART DISPLAY



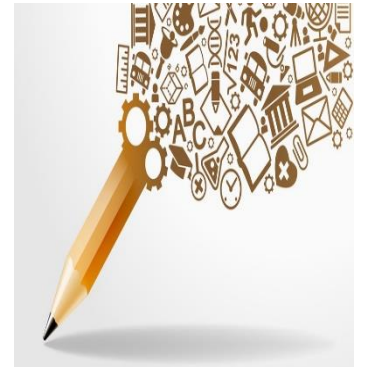
