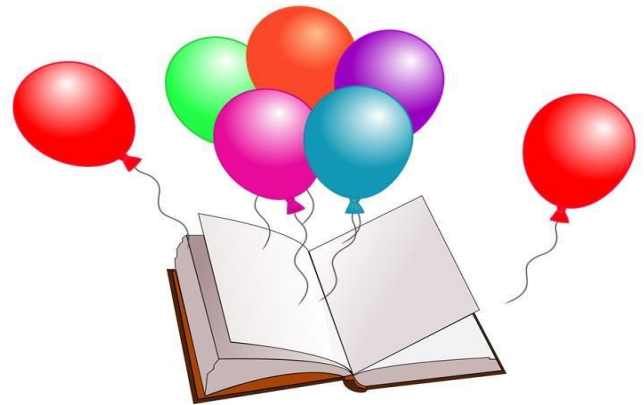
## OPEN HOUSE

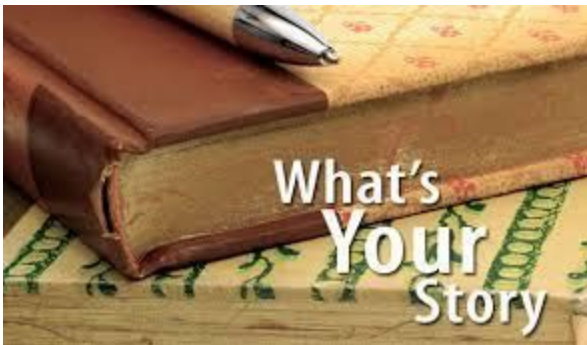


## SUMMER READING SUCCESS
